Their journey to dirt bike Baja California was a testament to the human spirit's ability to overcome challenges, embrace adventure, and create lasting memories.



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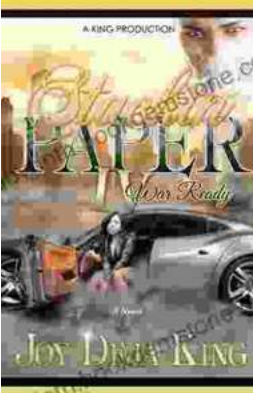
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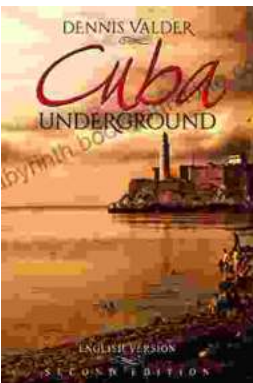
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
