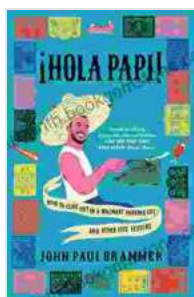


# How to Come Out in a Walmart Parking Lot and Other Life Lessons

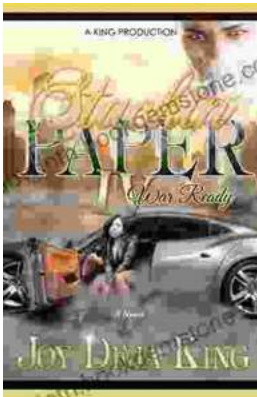

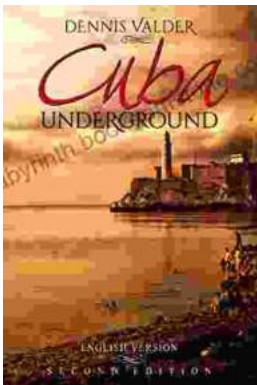
